

GUIDELINES FOR AUTHORS **[DRAFT]**

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- The **Romanian Journal of Medical Rehabilitation, Physical Medicine and Balneoclimatology (RJMRPMB)**, the official publication of the “*European Association of Neurological Recovery, Physical Medicine and Balneoclimatology*” (*EANRPMB*) “*Asociația Europeană de Recuperare Neurologică, Medicină Fizică și Balneoclimatologie*”, is devoted to the publication of the original investigations, observations, scholarly inquiries and reviews in the various branches of the medical recovery, physical medicine and balneoclimatology, a.o.
- All materials should comply with the Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals, prepared by the International Committee of Medical Journal Editors (<http://www.icmje.org>).

Preparation of Manuscripts

General considerations

- The language of the Journal is English. Authors are responsible for the linguistic accuracy of their papers.
- All manuscripts submitted for publication, will be checked for plagiarism detection and prevention.
- Self citation are as a common rule not allowed in RJMRPMB. If self-plagiarism is detected and the manuscript is accepted for publication, the author will be made aware of the offending sections and kindly ask to either rewrite the duplicated text or to rewrite and cite the original source if however the current topic is somehow connected over the years to previous studies of his/her own.

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You should arrange your paper in the following order:

1. **Title page**, including article title (less than 80 characters). Do not use abbreviations in the title or heads. Section titles should be typed capitalized
2. **Author(s) names** in exact order as specified in the Authorship agreement Everytime when the authors have an equal contribution specify clearly
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5. **Address of the first author** for distribution of one hard copy of the Journal issue in which his/hers article has been published.
6. **Abstract** must accompany each paper (**150-250 words at maximum**). The abstract should reflects the content of the article accurately. The abstract has to be structured and must clearly provide the background for the study, should state the study s objectives, methods used, main results, and principal conclusions.
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8. **Text** of manuscript should be edited electronically in **WORD on A4 format** (210x297 mm), with double spacing, margins of 25 mm, on one side only, consecutively numbered. Times New Roman font, 12-point size, is required.
- **Please never send a pdf. copy** of your manuscript, printed or electronically. As a general rule, a paper of about 5000 words, plus figures and tables, should not exceed 12 pages.
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 - Avoid footnotes. When essential, they are indicated in the text by symbols, typed at the foot of the appropriate page, e.g. the address of the author for correspondence (*) on the title page.
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 - Identify references in text, tables, and legends by Arabic numerals in square brackets (e.g. [1], [2-6], etc.).

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- Tables should have a short, descriptive heading.
- To construct the tables, use the table function of a word processor. Give each column a short or abbreviated heading. Place explanatory matter in footnotes to the table, not in the heading.
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- Tables should be self-explanatory and understandable: however the reference to the text of the article is highly recommended.
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
